1. Text: "Easy Reader" (1'200 – 1'700 words; Level 3 or 4)
2. Time: the talk lasts ~10 min
3. Tense: always use the present tense
4. Use short and simple sentences
5. Attention: -s (3rd pers. sg.)!
6. The talk is good, if your classmates can follow.
7. For a six you must talk freely
8. Read out an important and interesting passage
9. Write down the vocabulary on a sheet (15 – 20 words)
10. Use transparencies (not more than 5) to present a list of characters, list of chapters of your text, etc.
11. Give your opinion on the book at the end of your presentation (2 – 3 sentences)
12. Your talk represents a full mark!
