Today, close to the original site, visitors can walk around a reproduction of the original Pilgrims' village.

At Plimoth Plantation, one hour south of Boston, houses have been constructed from original materials, and the land is farmed just as it used to be almost 400 years ago. Actors who are wearing costumes play the parts of the settlers. The actors have taken over the names and identities of the men and women who actually lived there. They live and work just as the Pilgrims did and speak a variety of old English and Dutch dialects. Visitors can meet and talk to Captain Myles Standish, Master Isaac Allerton, Mistress Elizabeth Warren and many others. Visitors are encouraged to walk into the houses and join in the daily life of the community. The Plimoth actors are very well-trained and expect visitors to imagine they have travelled back in time and that they, too, live in that period.
