6. What does the creature do with the locket?
He takes the locket as he finds it on the boy. As he sees Justine sleeping, he puts it in her pocket, intending that she should take the blame for the murder.
7. What does the creature ask Frankenstein to do, and why?
He asks Frankenstein to create a female for him. He says that he is malicious because he is unhappy, and that if he is content he will not bother any more humans.
8. How does Frankenstein react to this request?
At first he refuses, but as the creature continues his argument, Frankenstein feels compassion for him, and finally agrees to create a female.
9. What threat does the creature make when he sees Frankenstein destroy his second creation?
He says, "I will be with you on your wedding night."
10. What happens to Frankenstein when he lands his boat?
He is accused of murder.
