to unfurl (32)	to open	<i>(sich) entfallen</i>
bud (32)	a flower or leaf that is not fully open	<i>Knospe</i>
daffodils (32)	a tall yellow spring flower	<i>Narzisse Osterglocke</i>
to spear up (32)	to grow into the air like a spear (<i>Speer</i>)	<i>„heraufspiessen“</i>
to graze (32)	to eat grass that is growing in a field	<i>grasen</i>
hillock (32)	a small hill	<i>Hügelchen</i>
to take snaps (32)	to take a photograph	<i>fotographieren</i>
to spread (33)	to open sth that has been folded	<i>ausbreiten</i>
tablecloth (33)	a cloth that you use for covering a table	<i>Tischtuch</i>
a pie (33)	fruit baked in a dish with pastry on the bottom, sides and top	<i>Obstkuchen, Pastete</i>
a loaf of bread (33)	an amount of bread that has been shaped and baked in one piece	<i>Brollaib</i>
a stove (33)	cooker	<i>Kocher (camping)</i>
to munch (33)	to eat sth steadily and often noisily	<i>mampfen</i>
kettle (33)	a container with a lid	<i>Kessel</i>
an earthquake (33)	a sudden, violent shaking of the earth's surface	<i>Erdbeben</i>
a jolt (33)	to move or to make sb/sth move suddenly and roughly	<i>Ruck</i>
to tremble (33)	to shake in a way that you cannot control	<i>zittern</i>
a gasp (33)	a quick deep breath, usually caused by a strong emotion	<i>Atemzug</i>
a yelp (33)	a sudden short cry, usually of pain	<i>kurzer Aufschrei</i>
to sag (34)	to hang or bend down in the middle	<i>absacken, durchbiegen</i>
to drag (34)	to pull sb/sth along with effort and difficulty	<i>zerren</i>
crack (35)	a line on the surface of sth where it has broken	<i>Spalt</i>
jagged (35)	with rough, pointed, often sharp edges	<i>schroff, zerklüftet</i>
to topple (35)	to become unsteady and fall down	<i>umstürzen</i>
to grope (35)	to try and find sth that you cannot see, by feeling with your hands	<i>herumtasten</i>
to drape (35)	to hang clothes, materials, etc. loosely on sb/sth	<i>behängen</i>
to groan (35)	to make a long deep sound because you are annoyed	<i>stöhnen</i>
to pound (35)	to hit sth/sb hard many times	<i>beschiessen</i>
anti-tank guns (35)	a military weapon to fight tanks	<i>Panzerabwehrkanone</i>

trial (36)	the process of testing sth	<i>Versuch</i>
barbed wire (36)	strong wire with short sharp points on it, used especially for fences	<i>Stacheldraht</i>
hinge (36)	a piece of metal, plastic, etc. on which a door, lid or gate moves freely as it opens or closes	<i>Scharnier</i>
tin can (36)	a metal container in which food and drink is sold	<i>Blachdose</i>
a ditch (36)	a long channel dug at the side of a field or road	<i>Strassengraben</i>
a clump of elm trees (36)	a small group of elm trees very close together	<i>eine Ansammlung von Ulmen</i>
dense (36)	difficult to see through	<i>dicht</i>
cattle truck (36)	a truck to transport cows and bulls	<i>Viehtransporter</i>
rusty (36)	covered with rust	<i>rostig</i>
horseshoe (36)	a piece of curved iron that is attached with nails to the bottom of a horse's foot	<i>Hufeisen</i>
to trap sb (37)	to catch sb	<i>fangen</i>
to deceive sb (37)	to make sb believe sth that is not true	<i>täuschen</i>
brass (37)	a bright yellow metal made by mixing copper and zinc	<i>Messing</i>
bough (37)	a large branch of a tree	<i>Ast</i>
cog (37)	one of a series of teeth on the edge of a wheel that fit between the teeth on the next wheel	<i>Zahnrad</i>
to hum (37)	to sing a tune with your lips closed	<i>summen</i>
scrap-metal yard (37)	a place where old cars, machines, etc. are collected	<i>Schrottplatz</i>
bedstead (38)	the metal frame of an old-fashioned type of bed	<i>Bettgestell</i>
girder (38)	a long strong iron or steel beam used for building bridges	<i>Tragbalken</i>
to pile up (38)	to become larger in quantity or amount	<i>anhäufen</i>
to rust away (38)	to be gradually destroyed by rust	<i>verrosten</i>
to gaze (39)	to look steadily at sb/sth for a long time	<i>anstarren</i>
to stretch out (39)	to lie down, usually in order to relax or sleep	<i>sich ausstrecken</i>
greasy (39)	covered in a lot of grease or oil	<i>fettig</i>
crumbs (39)	a very small piece of food, especially of bread or cake	<i>Krümml</i>
knob (39)	a round switch on a machine such as a television that you use to turn it on and off, etc	<i>Knopf</i>
crackle (39)	to make short sharp sounds like sth that is burning in a fire	<i>knistern</i>
delicacies (39)	a type of food considered to be very special	<i>Delikatessen</i>
to unload (39)	to remove things from a vehicle	<i>abladen</i>
to dangle (39)	to hang or swing freely	<i>baumeln, hängen</i>
gun barrel (39)	the part of a gun like a tube through which the bullets are fired	<i>Gewehrlauf</i>
